SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Dr. Suski thanked the men from the community who read to students at Reid and Fink for the recent 500 Men Reading event. Dr. Suski noted that a list of readers will be posted on the District website after the Kunkel event which will take place Friday, April 1, 2016.

Dr. Suski congratulated the MAMS Science Olympiad Team who placed 4th out of 21 middle schools at Saturday's competition at Millersville University. Dr. Suski said that students competed in 23 different events ranging from labs to exams and building competitions. According to Gifted Education teacher, Trevor Davis, "These events required serious study, research, planning, preparation, testing, building, and so much more. All of these events required skills and utilized concepts that are expected and sometimes taught at the high school level." The MAMS team's overall score placed them in 4th place which means they will advance to the state competition. The team also had students receive medals for placing in the top 4 for 9 individual events. The state competition will be held at Juniata College on April 23, 2016.

Dr. Suski noted that the third marking period closes this week. Dr. Suski said that as the District enters the last quarter of the school year, students and teachers have been preparing for the upcoming PSSA testing which will begin on April 11 and last throughout the month.
