## SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Dr. Suski congratulated Director Ryan Boyles and Vocal and Pit Directors Andrew Vensel and Sam Fisher for preparing the MAHS performing arts students well for their outstanding performance of *The Addams Family*. Dr. Suski congratulated Director Brian Massey on the MAMS first all-school musical *Seussical, Jr.* and noted that the students did an incredible job.

Dr. Suski said that on the previous Friday evening there was a great showing of community support as 12 seniors participated in the annual Mr. Middletown pageant to raise money for the Penn State Four Diamonds Fund. Dr. Suski said that following the pageant, several high school students took on the community in the annual Mayoral Madness basketball game. Mayor Curry appreciated the Board allowing use of the new MAHS gymnasium for his event, and the District was pleased that MAHS students were once again victorious over the mayor's adult team.

Dr. Suski announced that the third marking period closes on Thursday, March 30, 2017 and that report cards will be issued on April 5, 2017. Dr. Suski said that on Tuesday and Wednesday the District will conduct its biannual bus evacuation drills.

Dr. Suski announced that PSSA testing for English Language Arts begins next week for all students in Grades 3 – 8. Dr. Suski noted that teachers have been working very hard all year to deliver the curriculum in ways that will best prepare students for the rigor of these state assessments. Dr. Suski said that the Administration hopes that students will take the tests seriously and put forth their best effort.

Dr. Suski announced that due to the late winter snowfall two weeks ago, school will now be in session on Thursday, April 13. The missed day of instruction from March 15 will be made up by postponing the planned early dismissal on Wednesday, April 12 to Thursday, April 13. Thus the day will be made up in two consecutive half day increments so that teachers can have their scheduled contractual work time on the afternoon of April 13. School will be closed on Friday and Monday, April 14 and 17 for the spring recess.

The Board approved an early dismissal for students on the last day of school, Wednesday, June 7, 2017.

## AGREEMENTS

The Board approved an amendment to the Sponsorship Agreement with Harrisburg Area Community College to extend the term of the Sponsorship Agreement for a period of five years beginning with the 2017-2018 fiscal year through the 2021-2022 fiscal year with an estimated District outlay of \$172,645 in the initial year of the agreement.

The Board approved an agreement with Pinnacle Health CARES to provide health screenings to District employees as part of an employee wellness fair on May 16, 2017.

## PARTICIPATION

The Board approved the District's funding participation of \$10,000 to the Olmsted Regional Recreation Board during the 2016-2017 fiscal year.

The Board approved to apply to participate in the Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program at Fink and Reid Elementary Schools in the 2017-2018 school year. (Note: These are the only two schools eligible to participate.)

## EQUIPMENT PURCHASES

The Board approved the purchase of a replacement digital sound system for MAMS from Sage Technology Solutions.
