



Homebound instruction will be offered in the basic core classes or courses only. Course offerings would include appropriate topics in reading, language arts, mathematics, social studies, and science.

Exception

The Board reserves the right to withhold individual instruction when:

1. The instructor's presence in the place of a student's confinement presents a hazard to the health or safety of the teacher.
2. The teacher is subjected to verbal harassment or abuse.
3. The student refuses to attend instructional opportunities presented outside of the student's home in an alternate instructional area.
4. A parent/guardian or other adult in authority is not present with the student during the hours of instruction.
5. The student fails to attend or present him/herself for three (3) consecutive homebound instructional sessions or opportunities.
6. The condition of the student is such as to preclude his/her benefit from such instruction.
