CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES FOR CHARTER SCHOOL STUDENTS</p> <p>Students who participate in the co-curricular programs offered by the Middletown Area School District are expected to accept the responsibilities that accompany this privilege. Guidelines shall be established to govern participation in co-curricular activities by students enrolled in charter schools.</p> <p>Charter School – an independent non-sectarian public school established and operated under a charter from the Department of Education of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The charter school must meet the requirements set forth in the School Code of Pennsylvania.</p> <p>Co-curricular Activities – activities which are sponsored or approved by the Board and conducted wholly or partly outside the regular school day.</p> <p>The Superintendent, or designee, shall establish reasonable eligibility standards and procedures to document compliance with those standards and procedures.</p> <p>The charter school shall submit written reports to the district documenting the student’s academic eligibility.</p> <p>The charter school shall make attendance records available to the district.</p> <p>Students who elect to participate in the co-curricular programs offered by the district shall:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Adhere to all policies established by the Board that govern co-curricular programs and district students. 2. Adhere to the rules, regulations, and responsibilities that accompany this privilege.

The parent, guardian, or legal custodian shall assume responsibility for transporting the student to and from the assigned district facility for scheduled practices and events associated with the co-curricular activity.

Charter school students shall be subject to the same try-out criteria as other students who compete for positions on teams or squads.
