SUPPLEMENTAL DISCIPLINE RECORDS</p> <p>In accordance with law, the Middletown Area School District shall maintain required records concerning adjudicated students and students disciplined for offenses involving weapons, alcohol, drugs, and violence on school property.</p> <p><u>Students Adjudicated Delinquent</u></p> <p>Act 30 (SSI) of 1995</p> <p>Through the juvenile probation department, the court is required to report to school principals information concerning the adjudication of an enrolled student. Such reports shall include a description of delinquent acts committed by the student, disposition of the case, probation or treatment reports, prior delinquent history, the supervision plan, and any other information deemed necessary.</p> <p>The building principal must share this information with the student's teachers and the principal of another school to which the student may transfer. The information obtained from the juvenile probation department may not be used for admissions or disciplinary decisions concerning the delinquent child unless the act or acts surrounding the adjudication took place on or within 1500 feet of school property.</p> <p>The information received from the juvenile probation department shall be provided to the building principal of any public, private or parochial school to which the student transfers enrollment.</p> <p>Required reports concerning an adjudicated student shall be maintained separately from the student's official school record.</p>

<p>SC 1317.2</p>	<p><u>Sworn Statement by Parents Upon Registration of Student</u></p> <p>Act 26 of 1995</p> <p>Upon registration and prior to admission to the school district, the parent, guardian or person having control or charge of the student shall provide a sworn statement or affirmation stating whether the student previously was or presently is suspended or expelled from any public or private school of the Commonwealth or any other state for an offense involving weapons, alcohol or drugs, or for willful infliction of injury to another person, or for any act of violence committed on school property. The statement shall include the dates of suspension or expulsion and the name of the school from which the student was suspended or expelled.</p> <p>Parents and guardians shall be informed that any willful false statements concerning this registration shall be a misdemeanor of the third degree.</p> <p>This registration statement shall be maintained as part of the student's disciplinary record.</p> <p><u>Discipline Record of Student Transferring to the District</u></p> <p>When a student transfers to this district, a certified copy of the student's discipline record shall be obtained from the school from which the student is transferring. This record shall be maintained as part of the student's discipline record and shall be available for inspection as required by law.</p> <p><u>Students Transferring from the District</u></p> <p>Upon receipt of a request from a school entity to which a student has transferred from this district, a certified copy of the student's discipline record shall be supplied to the receiving district.</p>
