	<p>228. STUDENT GOVERNMENT</p>
1. Purchase	<p>The Board acknowledges the importance of offering students the opportunity to participate in self-government within the establishment of the schools.</p>
2. Authority	<p>Students shall have the right to organize, conduct meetings, elect officers and representatives and petition the Board.</p> <p>The Board will recognize the Student Council as the official voice of the student body for students in grades 6-12 and for the purpose of promoting better relations and cooperation among students, teachers and administrators.</p>
SC 511(c)	<p>The Board shall appoint a qualified member(s) of the faculty to serve as advisor(s) to student government activities.</p>
3. Delegation of Responsibility	<p>The Superintendent shall establish rules and regulations to implement this policy which:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Assure that all students have equal access to the student government and an equal opportunity to vote and hold office.</li> </ol>
SC 511(d) Pol. 618	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>2. Require fiscal accountability and adherence to Board policy for all financial aspects of student government activity.</li> <li>3. Require that decisions made and actions taken by the student government organization are in accordance with and within the scope of the constitution approved by the Board.</li> </ol>
