904.1. SPORTS PARK VEHICULAR ACCESS	
1. Purpose	<p>The purpose for recommending this policy is: (1) to promote safety within the sports facility area for students, officials and guests; (2) to control spectators and general public access to the sports facility; and (3) to assist in preventing damage to the sports facility and adjoining areas.</p> <p>The following procedures are outlined to control vehicular access to the Sports Park facilities during school district activities, Recreation Board activities and general public use.</p>
2. Delegation of Responsibility	<p>The responsibility for implementation and enforcement of these procedures is assigned to the Business Manager and Athletic/Recreation Director or their representatives.</p>
3. Guidelines	<p>It is accepted that all maintenance vehicles will have unlimited access year-round. Furthermore, deliveries made to the school may, from time to time, require access beyond control points established by this policy.</p> <p>Sports Park access points are located at the western end of the student parking lot and the service road entering from the north off PA Route #441. The two (2) access points will be controlled by a locked gate or chain crossing the access roads. Only those individuals authorized by this policy will be given access to keys to these locked entry ways.</p> <p>Key control is a major concern and thus will follow the established procedure for signing out keys. Keys will be signed for by the person receiving a key, and the signature card will be kept on file in the office of the Director for Building and Grounds.</p>

I. School District Activities

A. Fall Season

1. Coaches of sports in season (key)
  - a. Head Football Coach.
  - b. Assistant Varsity Coach.
  - c. 9th Grade Football Coach.
  - d. Head Soccer Coach.
  - e. Head Field Hockey Coach.
  - f. Head Cross Country Coach.
2. Visiting team buses.
3. Game officials.
4. Handicapped spectators.
5. Refreshment stand deliveries.

B. Winter Season (No Access)

C. Spring Season

1. Coaches of sports in season (Key)
  - a. Head Baseball Coach.
  - b. Junior Varsity Baseball Coach.
  - c. Head Track Coach.
  - d. Assistant Track Coach.
  - e. Head Soccer Coach.
  - f. Head Softball Coach.

D. Game Day

Gate will be monitored by school district personnel. (i.e. maintenance staff, crossing guard, or special part-time hire.)

E. Spectators for all sporting events will be required to park in lots provided except by reason stated in Section A-4.

II. Recreation Board Activities

A. Recreation and Park Personnel.

1. Director.
2. Assistant Director.
3. Legion team refreshment deliveries.
4. Field maintenance.

B. Spectators and participants for all activities must park in lots provided.

III. General Public Use

A. Parking is only permitted in the lots provided.

B. Parking is prohibited on all roadways within the school area.
