



Off The Streets provides the security deposit directly to the landlord, which is often the only thing preventing someone from being housed.

Many people experiencing homelessness have lost most, if not all, their material goods. To help settle them into their new home, **Off The Streets** helps to provide the basics: beds, dressers, chairs, tables, bedding, kitchen ware and other household items. Most of these items are donated.
